DECLARATION OF GEORGE GULISANO

- I, George Gulisano, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, hereby declare as follows:
- 1. I have been a certified public accountant since 1986, and am licensed to practice in Florida. I have 15 years of experience as an auditor in accounting firms, including Arthur Andersen & Company, Laventhol & Horwath and several other firms. I have also served as the chief financial officer for a number of companies over my career, including Royal St. Kitts Hotel

& Casino, Corporate Centers of America, and Managed Care of America. I served as chief financial officer for Jay Peak Resort and Jay Peak Biomedical Research Park LP (the "Biomedical Partnership") from 2011 until Michael Goldberg was appointed as the receiver for those companies. A copy of my most current CV is appended hereto as Exhibit A.

- 2. I have been retained by counsel for Ariel Quiros to provide expert testimony regarding various financial matters in this case. Specifically, I was asked to prepare a schedule and back up materials showing how funds invested by EB-5 investors in the Biomedical Partnership was used by the Partnership. In order to perform this task, I used documents and information that was provided to the SEC by the Biomedical Partnership and its general partner, AnC Bio Vermont GP Services, LLC. Much of the information provided to the SEC and used in this assignment was gathered by me while I was CFO of the Biomedical Partnership. The documents and information I reviewed and used was limited to periods up through and including December 31, 2015, and did not include any information about the Biomedical Partnership after that date. Although I am currently employed by the Receiver, who knows that I have separately undertaken this work, I did not used any of the records in the Receiver's custody or control to perform my work in order to avoid any assertion that I was improperly using such information and resources.
- 3. My conclusions are summarized in Exhibit B hereto. As noted therein, approximately \$82.4 million was raised from the EB-5 investors in the Biomedical Partnership as of December 31, 2015. As of that same date, a little over \$17.7 million remained in the Biomedical Partnership's possession, either in an escrow account pending approval of investors' applications by United States Citizenship and Immigration Service, or in the Partnerships operating account. The schedule shows how the remaining approximately \$66.4 million of Partnership funds was spent.

4. Appended hereto as Exhibits C through F are materials supporting the conclusions set out in Exhibit B. All of these materials were produced to the SEC or derive from materials produced to the SEC that came from the Biomedical Partnership's books and records. Exhibit C is a schedule showing EB-5 investor contributions. Exhibit D is the payment register for the Biomedical Partnership showing all expenditures between 2012 and December 31, 2015. Exhibit E is a monthly flow of funds schedule derived from the payment register. And Exhibit F is a balance sheet for the Biomedical Partnership as of December 31, 2015.

Currently, I serve (I was hired in 2011) as CFO of an EB5 project, (United States Immigration Service 5th Employment based Program) Jay Peak Biomedical Research Park, L.P. This \$110,000,000 dollar project located in Newport, Vermont is a 70,000 square foot research laboratory that is to be FDA "clean room" certified and will manufacture artificial organs and conduct stem cell and other high level medical research in its state of the art facility. Construction began in 2015.

From 1996 -2000, I provided Managed Care of America, PPO, Inc. (MCA) with health related consulting services in connection with a pending multi-million dollar contract to provide consulting, operating and managerial expertise for a major Argentinean healthcare organization. In 1997, I founded GAG Consulting, Inc. to provide consulting services to clients and I formed a joint venture with MCA & PricewaterhouseCoopers to perform this engagement. I worked closely with the Project Director, Harold Dankner of PWC- Washington, in carrying out MCA's contractual obligations. Mr. Dankner, now retired, was partner in charge of U.S. health care consulting for PWC.

In March 1997, I accepted the President/COO position of Managed Care of Argentina, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary, established to fulfill the terms of the aforementioned contract. Concurrently, I was named the Chief Operating Officer of Solidaridad (Bankers Union Health Trust) a provider of health services to 410,000 members in Argentina. Solidaridad employs 1,600 persons with approximately 60 branches throughout Argentina with its own 300 bed hospital (Policlínico Bancario) located on a 17 acre campus in the heart of the Federal Capital of Buenos Aires.

Responsibilities included, day-to-day operations, medical contracting, personnel, systems, branches, and oversight over the hospital, marketing and customer service. In the first nine months of the consulting agreement, we were able to achieve cost reductions of approximately 36 million dollars (annualized) with major improvements in medical services provided on a nationwide basis.

The resort owns and operates various recreation facilities including: a hotel, ski lifts and trails, golf course, 9 restaurants, 4 retail and pro shops, which include rental and repair services, and a ski school. In addition, the Company constructed, sells, and manages 300 condominiums at the Jay Peak Ski Resort.

Through the EB5 program it developed additional facilities which include: three new hotels, a hotel conference center, indoor water park, indoor skating rink and hockey arena, 210 rental cottages and townhouse units and a golf clubhouse. The Company is the project manager for the construction of these real estate projects. Jay Peak had 350,000 skier visits and 300,000 water park visits in its 2015 fiscal year. Based on the success of the Jay Peak project, the owner purchased Burke Mountain Ski Resort in Burke, Vermont in May 2012, where I became Chief Financial Officer. The resort operates various recreation facilities including: ski lifts and trails, restaurants, a ski shop rental and repair services, and a ski school. A \$98,000,000 million dollar EB5 project has been approved for Burke which includes two hotels, an indoor aquatic center and indoor /outdoor tennis complex in the first phase. The project broke ground in the spring of 2014 and was completed in 2016. Burke had 72,000 skier visits and employed a workforce of 300 during its 2015 fiscal year.
